Characters:

Santa Claus – The jolly host of the talent show.

Mrs. Claus – Santa's supportive and witty partner.

Jingle - A mischievous elf who loves to tell jokes.


Snowflake – A shy but talented ice dancer.

Rudy - A reindeer with dreams of being a stand-up comedian.

Holly – A confident singer who wants to share her voice with the world.

Frosty – A snowman who loves to juggle snowballs.

Twinkle - A magical star who grants wishes and spreads joy.















The Announcement

(The stage is set at the North Pole. There is a big sign that reads "North Pole Talent Show Tonight!"

Santa Claus: (*Excitedly*) Ho ho ho! Welcome, everyone, to the first-ever Great North Pole Talent Show! We've got a spectacular lineup.

Mrs. Claus: (Smiling) That's right, Santa! And I hear we have some surprises in store, too. I can't wait to see what everyone's been practicing!

Santa Claus: Tonight, we celebrate the wonderful talents of our North Pole family!

Mrs. Claus: (*Nudging Santa*) And remember, Santa, it's not a competition—it's all about having fun and sharing joy

Jingle: (Bounding in with excitement) Oh, I'm ready, Mrs. Claus! I've been practicing my jokes all week! Why did the gingerbread man go to the doctor? Because he felt crummy! (Giggles)

Santa Claus: (*Laughs*) Ho ho ho! Good one, Jingle. Now, let's get started with our first act!

Mrs. Claus: Just remember everyone to try your best and we know you will all do a fantastic job.

Santa Claus: Yes, we all know how talented you all are working at the North Pole now we want to see what other special talents you have


Jingle: Don't worry Sir, I am ready to show you what else I can do besides making toys and I promise no funny business. Well except for when I'm telling jokes, because then I want to be funny. (*laughs at himself*)

Mrs. Claus: Don't worry Jingle we all know how funny you are.
Okay we are going to get into places for the first act. Santa
why don't you take a seat here and let the show begin!









Snowflake: (Speaking to herself, nervously) Okay, Snowflake, you can do this. Just like you practiced...

Mrs. Claus: Let's welcome our first act to the stage, Snowflake

Snowflake: (Shyly) Um... hi, everyone. I'm Snowflake, oh sorry you already said that. And... I'll be doing an ice dance. This is my first time doing something like this.....

Santa Claus: Just take a deep breath. I'm sure you will do great. (gives her a thumbs up)

(The music starts. Snowflake begins her dance, gracefully gliding across the stage. The audience claps along. Halfway through, she slips, but Rudy, the reindeer, steps in to help.)

Rudy: (Whispering) Don't worry, Snowflake! I've got your covered.

Isn't she amazing folks? Have you ever seen someone glide like that. In fact the way she moves reminds me of a joke. What do you call a snowman with a six-pack? An abdominal snowman! (Winks)

(Everyone laughs, and Snowflake regains her confidence, finishing her dance with a spin.)



Santa Claus: Wonderful job, Snowflake! And great save, Rudy! (Claps)



Snowflake: (Takes a bow) Thank you Rudy! I'm so glad you all liked it. I was a little nervous at first but your cheers helped.

Mrs Claus: (Clapping) So very talented

Rudy: Yes she is, but you know what time it is? Time for another joke. Why did the Christmas tree go to the barber Because it needed a trim!





Santa Claus: Good one! Can you imagine a Christmas tree going to the barber?

Rudy: I have another one for you. Why don't reindeer play hide and seek? Because good luck hiding with these antlers! (Points to his antlers)

(The audience laughs louder, and Rudy gains confidence.)

Rudy: And what does a reindeer say before telling a joke? This one will sleigh you! (Winks)

(The audience applauds, and Rudy takes a bow.)

Mrs Claus: Wonderful job, Rudy! You've got quite the knack for comedy!

Rudy: (Continues to bow) Oh you are too kind! Thank you my fans. My people

(Snowflake comes back on)

Snowflake: I think it is time for another act don't you Rudy?

Rudy: But they love me. They really love me.

Snowflake: Of course they do! (she pulls him off the stage as he waves to the crowd)

Santa Claus: (laughing) Oh that Rudy! I can't wait to see who is next.

Mrs Claus: Me too! Who knew we had so much talent at the North Pole?

(Rudy comes running back on stage)


Rudy: One more folks! What do you call a reindeer who tells jokes? Me, of course!

Act 3: Holly's Song and Frosty's Juggling Act



Holly: Hello, everyone! I'm Holly, and I'm going to sing a song that's very close to my heart. I have rewritten the words for Deck the Halls. If you want to join in the Fa La La's I would love that.

Trim the tree and hang the tinsel, fa-la-la-la-la, la-la-la-la Snow is falling, oh so gentle, fa-la-la-la-la, la-la-la-la Sing a carol, spread the cheer now, fa-la-la, la-la-la, la-la-la It's the happiest time of year now, fa-la-la-la-la, la-la-la-la

Cookies baking in the kitchen, fa-la-la-la-la, la-la-la-la Grandma's scarf has us all itchin', fa-la-la-la-la, la-la-la-la Hear the sleigh bells softly ringing, fa-la-la, la-la-la, la-la-la Round the fire, we're all singing, fa-la-la-la-la, la-la-la-la

Stockings hung by the firelight, fa-la-la-la-la, la-la-la-la
Hot cocoa makes the night just right, fa-la-la-la-la, la-la-la-la
Cozy sweaters, warm and bright, fa-la-la, la-la-la, la-la-la
It's a perfect winter night, fa-la-la-la, la-la-la-la

Thank you (bows)

Mrs. Claus: Oh, Holly, that was absolutely beautiful! Your voice could warm even the coldest winter night!

Santa Claus: (Smiling) Indeed, Mrs. Claus! Holly, you are very clever to change the words to the song.

Holly: I just thought it would be fun to take something old and make it new again.

Mrs Claus: Great work!

Holly: Thank you! Next, we have Frosty the Snowman with his amazing juggling act!











Frosty waddles on stage, carrying several snowballs. He starts juggling three, then four, then five snowballs.

Frosty: Hi everyone! Like Holly said, you all know me. I'm Frosty the snowman and today I am going to juggle for you.



Mrs Claus: Wonderful

Frosty: (Concentrating) Here we go... one, two, three... (He adds more snowballs, but eventually, they all tumble down.)

Frosty: (Laughs) Oops! Looks like I tried to juggle too much snow! But hey, it's snow problem!


(The audience laughs, and Frosty takes a bow, picking up his snowballs.)

Santa Claus: Great effort, Frosty! Remember, practice makes perfect!

Frosty: (*Nodding*) Thanks, Santa! You're right. Next time, I'll juggle with even more snowballs!

Mrs Claus: I'm not sure that was what he was saying

Frosty: Hey! Maybe next time I could juggle on something while I do it. Like the sleigh or a reindeer.



Frosty: Right! Well thank you everyone and I promise next time I will have something really special to show you.

Santa Claus: I'm sure you will Frosty! (*chuckles*) Who do we have next?


Mrs Claus: It looks like we have Jingle the elf, but I haven't seen him in a while?





Act 4: Twinkle's Magical Wish and a Surprise Talent

(Twinkle, the magical star, walks in, shimmering with light.)



(Twinkle waves her hands, and the stage sparkles with a magical glow. Soft, beautiful snow begins to fall, and the audience oohs and aahs.)

Jingle: (comes running in) Wait!! I haven't had a chance to go yet. (he is tangled in lights falls to the ground and looks at the lights)

Wow, Twinkle! That's incredible!

Twinkle: Oh Jingle. What happened to you?

Jingle: Well, I was back stage practicing my jokes and then I started to feel some butterflies in my tummy so I had some hot cocoa and then I saw how amazing Snowflake was doing her dance. I didn't think my jokes would be good enough so I thought if I added lights to my number I could really impress all of you, but then I got kind of tangled in the lights and well here I am.

Twinkle: Let me help you Jingle. I know a thing or two about lights. I have an idea. Why don't you tell you jokes while I help.

Jingle: Oh okay I guess I can do that. (*clears his throat*)

What's Santa's favorite type of music? Wrap music! (the audience laughs)

Santa Claus: Good one

Jingle: What do snowmen eat for breakfast? Frosted flakes!

(everyone laughs as they walk on stage)









Frosty: It's funny and true

Jingle: What do elves learn in school?

The elf-abet! (every joke he becomes more confident and the lights are un twisted)

Holly: Ha! Elf-abet I get it!

Jingle: Why did Santa get a parking ticket on Christmas Eve? He left his sleigh in a snow-parking zone!

(the whole crowd is laughing and cheering and Jingle is untangled)

Jingle: Wow! You all like my jokes.

Twinkle: Of course we do because we like you even without the fancy lights.

Jingle: I think I will leave the lights to you from now on.

Twinkle: I think that is a good plan. (winks)

Santa Claus: Jingle, I think you just showed everyone that we all have hidden talents and that our talents are even better when we work together.

Mrs. Claus: (Smiling) That's right, Santa!

Twinkle: Like I said before I am here to share the holiday magic with all of you and it looks like you had it all along.

So I guess there is only one thing left to do.

Jingle: Eat Christmas cookies?

Twinkle: No, it's time for our grand finale!

Jingle: Ohhh I love a grand finale. Should I set up the lights?

Everyone: NO!

Jingle: Right, okay I was just checking.











Act 5: The Grand Finale

(All the characters gather center stage. Holly starts singing a joyful holiday medley, while Snowflake dances around her. Frosty juggles snowballs, Rudy tells a final joke, and Twinkle creates a shimmering light show and Jingle adds some comedic commentary.)

Santa Claus: (*Clapping along*) This is what the holidays are all about—coming together, sharing our talents, and having fun!

Mrs. Claus: (*Cheerfully*) And spreading holiday cheer to everyone!

(The entire cast comes together for a final bow, waving to the audience.)

All: Happy Holidays to all, and to all a joyful night!

(The curtain falls as everyone laughs, hugs, and continues celebrating on stage.)
